



BEQUEST INFORMATION

Residuary Bequest:

Specific Bequest:

Gifts of Life Insurance, IRAs, or Other Pension/Retirement Plans:

A will typically does not dispose of assets such as life insurance and pension plans, which usually pass by “beneficiary designation.” A beneficiary designation is a contract between you and your insurance company or pension plan administrator to transfer the asset at your death to the person(s) or institution(s) you have designated (usually in the initial paperwork you completed to establish the asset). To designate the American Diabetes Association as a recipient of an asset with a designated beneficiary, you should contact your insurance company or plan administrator and request a “change of beneficiary” form.
